- Union members have higher wages than non-union employees.
- Union contracts include better dental and health plans for families and 78% of union employees have employer-sponsored pension plans; compared to only 25% for workers without the benefits of union representation.
- Union wages help families make a decent income, making Canada's economy stronger by preserving the middle class.
- The USW negotiates contracts with higher pay increases than non-union workplaces.
